The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 16.1 in the identified area, compared to 64.0 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$42,100 in the area, compared to \$56,124 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$47,087 in five years, compared to \$62,316 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$59,367 in this area, compared to \$80,675 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$67,375 in five years, compared to \$91,585 for all U.S. households

Currently, 49.8% of the 6,802 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 19.7%, renter occupied; and 30.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 5,992 housing units in the area - 53.9% owner occupied, 18.0% renter occupied, and 28.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 5.80%. Median home value in the area is \$203,823, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.37% annually to \$207,584.
