Currently, 50.3% of the 43,844 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 38.1%, renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 42,211 housing units in the area - 54.3% owner occupied, 35.0% renter occupied, and 10.8% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.70%. Median home value in the area is \$113,828, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.29% annually to \$127,485.
