Current average household income is \$67,898 in this area, compared to \$80,675 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$77,240 in five years, compared to \$91,585 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$26,208 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$30,820. The per capita income is projected to be \$29,767 in five years, compared to \$34,828 for all U.S. households

Currently, 52.0% of the 38,228 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 37.8%, renter occupied; and 10.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 35,785 housing units in the area - 56.0% owner occupied, 34.3% renter occupied, and 9.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.98%. Median home value in the area is \$125,693, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.19% annually to \$140,092.
